The Bible tells us that the mark of the beast is coming.

Rev 13:17 And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.

Thunberg promotes Sunday keeping as a way to heal the planet. Furthermore, it amazes me that the Green New Deal is being promoted by the SUNrise movement. On top of this another movement was formed when many UN leaders went to India this year including French Prime Minister Emmanuel Macron called the Solar Alliance and they had a prayer to the Sun God at that time.



Barb's pain disappeared, and she slept the entire night and never woke up for 8 hours straight. Amazing.





OVERCOMING COMPLAINING AND STRIFE

Have you ever had trials where you've fallen short and given way to frustration, overcome by emotions, anger, even to the point of having hatred in your heart towards someone that God told you in His word you should love. Jesus said "love your enemies." (Matt 5:44)

The Bible says "Do all things without murmurings and disputings:" (Phi 2:14)

But what about that guy who just cut you off on the street the other day? Or what about your wife who didn't have your dinner ready for you when you came home? Or what about your husband who didn't say I love you before he left for work? Or what about your child who left their toys on the floor and didn't clean up? Or what about the dog poop you stepped in walking to the park? Or what about the waiter who didn't ask if you wanted a refill or brought you the wrong food? Or what about the poor attendant at the cash register trying to make ends meet who isn't moving fast enough for you because you have to get to work? What about the red light that you just got on the way to an appointment?

What about complaining and arguing when something isn't going my way? Was Jesus just saying to try our best.

Have you ever had a bad day and felt that you were justified in complaining about it to everyone you come in contact with?

James 1:2-4 My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations; Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience. But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing.

What about when my son got killed in an accident? What about when I get cancer? What about when my car gets scratched? What about if my wife cheats on me? Count it all joy? YES.

This is about to get really serious isn't it? I've brought up a lot of practical situations, and in these situations do we see practical Christians? Not very often. Most Christians don't handle these situations counting it all joy and letting patience have its perfect

work. In fact, I might even say that on very rare occasions do we see these attributes in most Christians today. Why not? It really comes down to one thing, and that is our faith. God wants us to take Him at His word. His word has the power in it, but the flesh, and the natural feelings often get the better of most, many times even the best of Christians.

The Bible tells us regarding Israel in the wilderness, that they had some issues with the food God was serving them. They began to complain about his waiting on them. The waiter wasn't giving enough options on the menu according to them. And the Bible tells us what happened.

1Corinthians 10:10-11 Neither murmur ye, as some of them also murmured, and were destroyed of the destroyer. Now all these things happened unto them for ensamples: and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come.

Pretty serious judgment. And the same judgment will come on those who practice complaining in this last day. Therefore how is it that we can overcome? We need to look to Christ. Christ was 40 days in the wilderness and didn't eat, and not a complaint came out of his mouth. We are told the following:

Deuteronomy 8:2-3 And thou shalt remember all the way which the LORD thy God led thee these forty years in the wilderness, to humble thee, and to prove thee, to know what was in thine heart, whether thou wouldest keep his commandments, or no. And he humbled thee, and suffered thee to hunger, and fed thee with manna, which thou knewest not, neither did thy fathers know;that he might make thee know that man doth not live by bread only, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of the LORD doth man live.

In other words, when suffered to hunger, we are to learn to trust the word of God and not complain and dispute. Jesus walked up the hill, and we could say that if anyone ever had a right to complain it was him. He healed the sick, cleansed the lepers, did good everywhere he went and never complained. He was whipped and beaten, his disciples denied him, and he never complained, the Bible says he opened not his mouth.

And so what about us? When God allows it to rain on us, why is He allowing bad things to happen to good people? So that we

might learn that man Is not dictated by the feelings or the circumstances, or the people around us. But rather we are what we are by the grace of God. We are what we are because of what Christ did on the cross. And therefore when squeezed, the fruit that comes out is only good fruit.


If you squeeze an apple you get apple juice. If you squeeze an orange you get orange juice. If you got any orange juice when squeezing an apple or viceversa that would just be weird. So why isn't it weird that when we squeeze a Christian we find everything else coming out but Christ. Are we deceived? Regarding the works of the flesh we are told that "they which do such things shall not inherit the Kingdom of God." (Gal 5:21)

So how do we think we can justify doing those things such as strife or disputings and complainings and yet believe that we will be there in heaven. These character issues must die. But many have fought the battle and lost so many times that they have felt that this is just the way they are and sadly many will seek to invent a new standard so that they might inherit the Kingdom

of God. But the Bible is clear, and it is the standard. And for those who are changing the word of God to suit their emotions, I counsel you to let the word of God change you so that you are no longer guided by your emotions.

Feelings can be the devils playground, and he would certainly have us complaining about why we have to go through or put up with what we do. But our Father wants us to shine in these situations remembering that "we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to *his* purpose." (Rom 8:28)

Have you been touched the wrong way? Have you been spoken to the wrong way? Picked on? Put down? Has someone destroyed your property? Are you suffering with a disease? A disability? God has suffered us that we might learn that we like
