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WHY DOES GOD —ALLOW— SUFFERING ?

Why Does God Allow Suffering?

The name "Adam" means "man-kind". In the bible we are told that God gave Adam (mankind) "dominion". (Genesis 1:26) The word "dominion" implies "ruler" or "king". It implies ownership:

Genesis 1:26 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

God said to His Son Jesus, let's make humanity after our image, and let's give them dominion over the planet. And when God said it, He really meant it. He wasn't playing around. The man was told to trust the Father's instructions regarding the planet since the Father had designed it for him, especially His instructions concerning a tree in the middle of the garden called the tree of knowledge of good and evil, not to eat of it or else he would die. (Gen 2:17)

Now, consider this parallel, if I gave you a car, and said it's a gift to you, but don't drive it over 60 miles per hour around corners or else you might kill yourself. And you didn't listen to me and you wrecked that car. Who would be at fault if it got ruined? The one who gave the gift, or the one who wrecked the gift?

Could you come to me and say "Wow, what a piece of junk you gave me?" Or maybe you could say that the accident was my fault and I shouldn't have gave you the car in the first place. That if I hadn't given you the car, then it would never have happened. Maybe I could have stepped in and stopped you from misusing the gift and not gave you the ownership. In the same sense have we perhaps been blaming God for wrecking the world that He gave to us? Wasn't it in perfect condition when He gave it to us?

Why does God allow rape, murder, and suffering? Why do all the animals suffer? Again, because you were given dominion. Take for instance



your children. They are a gift from God. They are given to you. Now in ancient times children were sacrificed in the fire and many other wicked things by the parents. Why did God allow that? Because when God gave you this world or those children, He also gave you free will to do with this gift what you want. Does God want to see us suffering? Absolutely not. He desires us to turn from our wicked ways and live. All suffering is the result of turning from God, and He allows us to do this to one another. His government of freewill must prevail. Only sin must have its time to play out. And those who will turn from it will be saved.



The bible tells us that He is "not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance." (2 Peter 3:9) The bible tells us that the reason for suffering and death is sin. "For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." (Romans 6:23)

God has allowed wickedness to continue since the beginning when Eve took the fruit from the tree and did eat. So the consequence was death. As with a good law, the law could not be changed. God knew what was best for her as the creator, yet she disobeyed the good advice, dishonoring her Father, and taking something that was not hers, and now by this had brought disease and suffering upon herself. And also Adam who partook, brought this upon their children who suffer from the consequence of their sin. This is why we suffer. We are part of the family of Adam.

All of this suffering was the result of distrusting the plain word of God. It was Satan who inspired this distrust with the question "Hath God said?" (Genesis 3:1) The very first words out of his mouth was a question meant to get humanity to distrust God's word. The second statement called God a liar by saying that if she ate she would "not surely die". (Genesis 3:4) Because God would not force His will upon us, He has allowed humanity

to suffer under the curse that they have brought upon themselves. Yet instead of destroying us right then and there, He has provided a way to escape this world which is engulfed in misery. The bible says: Galatians 3:13 Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:

The bible tells us that Jesus Christ who was "in the form of God" (Phillipians 2:6) took upon himself the "form of a servant and was made in the likeness of men" (Verse 7) So that he could suffer "the death of the cross" (verse 8). He paid the price for you. The word "redeemed" means to "pay". And he "redeemed you from the curse".

You see it is really quite simple. The bible says that "Sin is transgression (Breaking) of the law" (1 John 3:4) And since "all have sinned" or broken God's law, (Romans 3:23) and "the wages of sin is death" (Romans 6:23) Then we must all suffer this penalty. Now God "not willing that any should perish" (2 Peter 3:9) and his law being "perfect" and unchangeable. (Psalms 19:7) Himself being life and "the only immortal" (1 Tim 6:16) He offered His only begotten Son to save you. (John 3:16) Jesus was the only one capable of giving his life for you. His spotless life for your polluted one. Not a fair exchange, but yet he saw your potential and was willing to pay for it.

He has given you free will and He will never force you to have eternal life or to accept the free gift. He does not save you because you were a good person or anything you've done. The standard is the ten commandments, and they have been broken. Ask yourself if you've ever lied, stolen, blasphemed. You owe something you can't pay.



But instead "God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." (Romans 5:8) It is not just pray a prayer or believe to be saved and go to heaven. The bible says that the devil believes in God. (James 2:19) It's not to do your best, be a good person and God will save you. But the call is to believe every word, and accept it, to repent from your sin (law breaking). To repent means to turn, and accept that Christ took your penalty on that cross. Be

free from it as He promised. And now you are an ambassador of that kingdom and are to go forth and share this good news with others who don't realize that they have the same need.

"Do unto others as you would want done to you." (Matthew 7:12)
