

SLUMBER NOT - PROPHECY UPDATE

In June of 2015 Pope Francis released his environmental encyclical Laudato Si concerning the state of the environment. Many who understand Bible Prophecy were at once alarmed. In the encyclical we read: “Sunday, like the Jewish Sabbath, is meant to be a day which heals our relationships with God, with ourselves, with others and with the world. Sunday is the day of the Resurrection, the “first day” of the new creation,...” (Laudato Si 237)



of Europe in blood for centuries.” (James Madison)

Now in the above quote Pope Francis himself admits that Sunday is the “first day” of the week, and therefore is saying plainly that Sunday is NOT the seventh-day. But yet God’s tables of the covenant will be revealed soon from heaven and will plainly say “The Seventh day is the Sabbath of the LORD thy God.” (See Exo 20:8-11, Rev 11:19)

Less than three months later Pope Francis made his first visit to the United States, but not only that, he was invited to address the congress of the United States, the people that are elected to uphold the constitution. A constitution that specifically outlines that the lawmakers are to protect the people from any church and state union.

James Madison, who was the fourth president of the United States, but more than this is also known for writing the document that formed the model of the constitution told us why the first amendment was put into the constitution.

“The purpose of separation of church and state is to keep forever from these shores the ceaseless strife that has soaked the soil

In other words the constitution was written to keep the Church from using the State to enforce its beliefs on others. It was written in a way that would prevent the Roman Church or any Church for that matter from having power to make laws. The Bible tells us that the Church is to serve, not to rule.

Pro 30:21-22 For three things the earth is disquieted, and for four which it cannot bear: For a servant when he reigneth;...

Number one on the list of things the earth cannot bear is a servant or church when it reigns as King. This was manifest during the dark ages of Christianity when for centuries the Catholic Church soaked the soil of Europe in blood. But furthermore, not only were there countless millions of people killed, but it was those who began to believe the Bible and question the motives of the Church that were targeted.

Rev 17:2 With whom the kings of the earth have committed fornication, and the inhabitants of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her fornication.

God's Church is represented by a pure woman in Bible Prophecy. (See Jer 6:2, Gal 4:26, Eph 5:25, 26, Rev 12) This OTHER woman however is guilty of fornication with State power and has only filled the cup with the blood of martyrs.

History repeats itself, Babylon is fallen, is fallen.... Again and again, this message has been repeated throughout history, she has been judged and weighed in the balances because of her fornication with the kings of the earth. (See Rev 17:1, 2, 18:1-4)

The day after Pope Francis made a speech to the congress where he mentioned that their were "wounds" that needed to be "healed." Yes you will find those words in the transcript of his speech. The next day he was on to his next endeavor in New York City where he would meet with several Kings, Princes, Presidents, Prime Ministers of the earth at the United Nations in a meeting concerning Agenda 2030 which was made into effect in Paris France in April 2016. Obama during his closing months in office also entered the United States into the agreement. Yet less than a year later in June 2017, President Trump reversed course and announced the U.S. would pull out.

Rev 13:3 And I saw one of his heads as it were wounded to death; and his deadly wound was healed: and all the world wondered after the beast.

Many of us have understood that this verse in Bible Prophecy has referred to the Papacy. And that this chapter which concerns the beast and its mark has to do with a future enforcement of the mark which is Sunday.

"Of course the change (from Sabbath to



Sunday) was her act and the act is a **MARK of her ecclesiastical power and authority** in religious matters." (signed by H.F.Thomas, Chancellor for Cardinal Gibbons, in a letter dated Nov. 11, 1895)

And furthermore, as many of us already know, the United States is also mentioned in this prophecy as a beast with two horns, and no crowns on those horns implies no king, and no Pope. Unlike the previous beast with ten crowns. This beast comes up lamblike. But then we are told will exercise all the power of the first beast when this WOUND is healed.

Rev 13:11-12 And I beheld another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb, and he spake as a dragon. And **he exerciseth all the power of the first beast** before him, and causeth the earth and them which dwell therein to worship the first beast, **whose deadly wound was healed.**

Due to provisions in the Agreement specifying details for any participants potentially leaving, the U.S. couldn't actually withdraw until November 2020 at the earliest. This means that America is still bound to the treaty for Trump's first term, no matter what.


Paris Agreement Has Been a 'Rallying Cry' for Green Lobby.

In other words what Donald Trump did worked to press the climate agenda ahead further than ever, and the Democrats including Al Gore and others were only thanking President Trump.

Bill HR 9 - A Sunday Law?

Recently a Bill passed the house that would stop Donald Trump from being able to exit the Paris Accord. Some recent prophecy students are calling this a national Sunday law and have said that the National Sunday Law would come to pass in the spring of 2019. However, this bill has to pass the senate and also be signed into law by President Donald Trump and is very unlikely to pass the senate.

Also, its not spring anymore, and therefore this Bill will not be signed into law in the spring of 2019. I've done some previous articles and videos that show some of the flaws in these teachings concerning the third angels



message and that this message is "not to be hung on time" and that we will never again have messages that will be.

Also, the Sunday laws are incremental, there are many aspects to the Sunday law. But we are not to put time prophecies on these events. Though there is mention of Sunday in Pope Francis environmental encyclical and this is to be considered law for the church.

And even recently Comece, which is the Commission of the Bishops' Conferences

of the European Union (EU) along with the ILO or International Labor Organization which is a United Nations (UN) organization have created a document together on Shaping the Future of work and all connects to the Paris accord. Where they tell us plainly that they want to:

“Reintegrate Sunday protection into EU law: ... Sundays, we recommend that the EU protects Sunday in a revised Working Time Directive as a collective day of rest.” (Page 34)

Though nothing came to pass in the spring of 2019, it is no time to go to sleep. Recent school strikes by millions of children in the last couple months have alarmed the multitudes to the idea that climate action is needed now, and it is a matter of time before Workers Unions begin to strike and the cry is made that there must be a change in the economic order of things. This is already being done to a large degree.

New York Climate Leadership Act

In New York State last month a bill was passed called the Climate Leadership and Community Protection Act. And this is expected to lead the way for many other States. It is being touted as New York’s Green New Deal. Some who have been keeping updated may have read about the Sunrise movement in other articles. There is no doubt that deep down this is the Sunday movement and we are well on our way.

New York also passed a bill ending its religious exemptions to vaccinations. They also have recently passed recent abortion laws that have shown the

United States the ungodly direction they are moving in. Very few will recognize the issues for this time.

The press towards the final decree “that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark...of the beast.” is on. The media giants are clamping down more and more on what they deem to be “fake news” or “hate speech” and they are shutting down the voice of those with concerned opinions concerning the coming crisis.

Some will continue to say “all things continue on as they were.” But can we afford to sleep now? Prepare your minds saints. Fill your hearts with the promises of God now. But also share the message with the people that the time is short.

“Fearful is the issue to which the world is to be brought. The powers of earth, uniting to war against the commandments of God, will decree that “all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond” (Revelation 13:16), shall conform to the customs of the church by the observance of the false sabbath. All who refuse compliance will be visited with civil penalties, and it will finally be declared that they are deserving of death. On the other hand, the law of God enjoining the Creator’s rest day demands obedience and threatens wrath against all who transgress its precepts.” [Great Controversy Page 604 1911]

It might be a fearful message for many and that is what it takes sometimes to motivate others to read, learn and understand that we have a NEED. Without the fearful warnings, the people will not be

stirred.

“The sins of Babylon will be laid open. The **fearful** results of **enforcing the observances of the church by civil authority**, the inroads of spiritualism, the stealthy but rapid progress of the papal power—all will be unmasked. **By these solemn warnings the people will be stirred.** Thousands upon thousands will listen who have never heard words like these. In amazement they hear the testimony that **Babylon is the church, fallen because of her errors and sins, because of her rejection of the truth sent to her from heaven.** As the people go to their former teachers with the eager inquiry, Are these things so? the ministers present fables, prophesy smooth things, to soothe their fears and quiet the awakened conscience. But since many refuse to be satisfied with the mere authority of men and demand a plain “Thus saith the Lord,” the popular ministry, like the Pharisees of old, filled with anger as their authority is questioned, will denounce the message as of Satan and stir up the sin-loving multitudes to revile and persecute those who proclaim it” [Great Controversy Page 606, 607 1911]

These words were written more than 100 years ago concerning the issue that the world was to be brought into, and now like never before the words of the prophets are coming to pass. Many will denounce the message as from Satan. Yet, the clarity and brightness of the angel that is lightening the earth with the glory of God will draw all men to it. (Rev 18:1-4) We must pray that some will turn from the “sin loving” multitude and forsake those ways.-DB

We have a very exciting announcement.

This camp meeting will be at Booker T State Park near Chattanooga, TN.

We have this place booked from October 13th which will be the check-in day until October 22nd.

The fellowship we've had at the last two meetings was incredible and such a blessing and we are looking forward to coming together again.

This park is located on Lake Chickamauga. The weather in this area is beautiful at this time of the year. And we are expecting a wonderful turnout. Many brothers and sisters are confirmed already.

We are only 3 and a half months away. So here are the details concerning the accommodations so that you can make plans and we can all prepare together.

We have a beautiful meeting hall with the cooking facilities attached. The meeting hall has 3 bedrooms as well in it with 6 beds.

We will have 12 roomy cabins with 4 sets of bunkbeds in each cabin.



That is a total of 96 beds on site. You will need your own bed coverings. You can also bring a tent if you wish.

The price for the 9 days will be \$70.00/bed. We also will have catered food which will cost each individual \$60.00. Children will cost \$30.00. 3 and Under free. Yes that's right, the price to eat for 8 days and sleep will be less expensive than living at home.

THE MAN THAT DOES THEM SHALL LIVE

Rom 10:5 For Moses describeth the righteousness which is of the law, That **the man which doeth those things shall live by them.**

Some have taken a verse like this to say that men who are doers of the law are working at achieving their salvation. Certainly Paul was saying that the law can't make a man do the law. But rather it is by faith in God to perform that which is written in us that the law is fulfilled. It is true that in the case of many there is the attempt to fulfill the law without faith.

We are told chapters earlier the following that **"the doers of the law shall be justified."** (Rom 2:13) The doers will live.

Now what does it mean to be justified? It means they are not condemned. It means they will have eternal life. So therefore the man which does them shall LIVE.

Let's unfold this a little bit more. In Matthew we read of Jesus account with the rich young ruler.

Mat_19:17 And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God: but **if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments.**

So therefore, in order to live, you must "keep the commandments" and if you don't do the commandments, the Bible is clear "the wages of sin is death" (Rom 6:23) and furthermore that "sin is transgression of the law." (1 John 3:4) Paul said himself "I had not known sin but by the law." (Rom 7:7)

So clearly Paul is not saying it is wrong to keep the law. God forbid. The Bible is clear then, the man that does them shall live, the man that doesn't do them shall not live.

Rom 7:10 And **the commandment,**

which was ordained to life, I found to be unto death.

Now why is this? Because he is walking after the flesh in Romans 7. In Romans 7 Paul talks of trying by his own strength to do the law. He says in verse 5 "when we were in the flesh, the motions of sins, which were by the law, **did work in our members to bring forth fruit unto death.**" The law killed him every time. Sin is breaking the law. It doesn't bring life when you break it. He struggled trying walk by the flesh, but by chapter 8 he goes on to explain:

Rom 8:1, 4 There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. **That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.**

There it is right there. The answer. And Paul is trying to have the Romans recognize this truth. He wants them to accept that Christ is living in them and that they are dead to sin.

Rom 8:9 But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit...

How can there be condemnation if you are fulfilling the law? There isn't. The flesh is crucified in the born again believer. (Gal 5:24)

Gal 3:21 Is the law then against the promises of God? God forbid: **for if there had been a law given which could have given life, verily righteousness should have been by the law.**

The man that does them shall live, however, the law in itself does not work righteousness and it cannot give life. It can only condemn, there is something greater that does work righteousness, and that is by beholding and seeing Christ crucified.

"The gospel... is the power of God unto salvation." (Rom 1:16)

Rev 22:14 Blessed are **they that do his commandments,** that **they may have right to the tree of life,** and may enter in through the gates into the city.



What is the opposite of "blessed"? Cursed. We'll come back to this as we continue, but concerning the text that was quoted from Leviticus 18:5, why does Paul quote the verse in the manner that he does? Well, this is the way that the Israelites tried to attain their eternal life. By doing the law. The promise to do all that the Lord had said was made at Mt. Sinai by the Israelites. They accepted that the law was good, but they made a promise of their own.

Eze 20:11-13 And I gave them my statutes, and shewed them my judgments, which if a man do, he shall even live in them. Moreover also I gave them my sabbaths, to be a sign between me and them, that they might know that I am the LORD that sanctify them. But the house of Israel rebelled against me in the wilderness: they walked not in my statutes, and they despised my judgments, which if a man do, he shall even live in them; and my sabbaths they greatly polluted: then I said, I would pour out my fury upon them in the wilderness, to consume them.

They didn't keep His statutes, they didn't keep the Sabbath, which if a man does, he would live. The commandment which was ordained to life they found to be unto death. They were missing something with that law, and that was the gospel, the power.

the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:

The law of itself couldn't make them righteous. Some when they read these things run away saying "Yay...Look we don't have to keep the law, I'm cursed if I do". Silliness. Romans tells us why they do this:

Rom 8:7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

Sin brings the curse, or breaking the law. But "blessed are they that do his commandments." (Rev 22:14) Be careful.

The book of the law mentioned in Galatians 3:10 is the book of Deuteronomy. This book consists of almost all moral statutes which define and explain the Ten Commandments which are in Chapter 5 of the book. In Chapter 27 we read "Cursed be he that confirmeth not all the words of this law to do them. And all the people shall say, Amen." (Deu 27:26)

Redeemed From the Curse

Rather than the Israelites promising to do all that the LORD said, they should have accepted the LORD to do His work in them, and said "AMEN." Then they would have been blessed. But because of a lack of faith, they didn't accept the word into their heart, and thus brought themselves under the curse of the law because they violated it.

In order for them to be saved, Christ came to pay the price or redeem them by shedding His blood. Thus the wages of sin and the curse have been paid. Now consider this, if a man has broken the law and murdered another man, he is brought to court, and he has desired another chance and is truly repentant in his heart. He is at this point under the curse or condemnation of that law.

The law being unchangeable requires the life of the murderer, and let us just say that the man is truly sorry and then another man steps in and says to the judge "I will take and suffer this mans penalty." Does the law then change after the other man takes the penalty? It is a good law the penalty still stands. Would the man then be free to go and violate that law and murder others now? Does the law and penalty change?

Obviously not. Christ took the penalty, and since the time that he took that penalty, that curse in that book of the law is still the same and the same rules still apply today as much as they did four thousand years ago. If the law could have just been changed, then why would heaven sacrifice their beloved commander to take the penalty for such a flimsy law. "Cursed is every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them." (Gal 3:10)

So therefore, there is still a curse on those who refuse to continue in all things written in the book of the law to do them. (Deu 27:26, Gal 3:13) But




The law was given in Exodus 20, the Israelites heard the statutes and judgments in Chapters 21-24, Moses went up to the mount in Exodus Chapter 25-31 and received the ceremonial aspects of the law which pointed to the remedy for sin. The sacrificial system, the priestly rites, and the sanctuary. They made a promise before they understood what those stood for. Christ, the gospel. They still hadn't heard it at this point and all they had was the law.

By the time Moses came down in Chapter 32, they had built a golden calf, broke their covenant, their promise, and finally realized that the law didn't justify them, it only condemned them. They had made a promise they couldn't keep based on their own unrighteous works. They needed the answer, which is Christ in you in order to keep the law.

The Book of the Law and the CURSE

Gal 3:10-13 For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: for it is written, **Cursed is every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them.** But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, The just shall live by faith. And the law is not of faith: but, **The man that doeth them shall live in them.** Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of



Christ has offered to take it.

As Many as are Of the Works of the Law

Now it did say "As many as are of the works of the law are under the curse." What does that mean?

Gal 2:16 Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ,...for by the works of the law shall no flesh be

justified.

Firstly, this question is for those who have a dispensational understanding of the covenants. If “no flesh is justified by the works of the law.” Consider the following:

Heb 11:3 By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain.

Was Abel justified by the works of the law or “by the faith of Jesus Christ?” No flesh was ever justified by the works of the law. Was Abel justified by works of the law or by faith? Obviously faith.

Heb 11:28 Through faith he (Moses) kept the passover, and the sprinkling of blood, lest he that destroyed the firstborn should touch them

Was Moses justified by the works of the law or “by the faith of Jesus Christ?” Obviously “by the faith of Jesus.”

Rev 14:12 Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.

When you have the faith of Jesus, you keep the commandments.

Since no flesh ever was justified by the works of the law, it is clear that Abel, Moses, David, and any other patriarch or prophet have never ever been justified by the works of the law. They were doers of the law. And in the same sense Paul wrote that those today in this dispensation of time after the cross must also be “doers of the law”:

Rom 2:13 (For not the hearers of the law are just before God, but the doers of the law shall be justified.

Yes, that is what Paul wrote. No flesh is justified by the works of the law, yet the justified are doers of the law. However, there is only one way by which you can do them. In Romans 10 where Paul clarifies what righteousness by faith looks like.

Deuteronomy Teaches Righteousness by Faith

Rom 10:6-8 But the righteousness which is of faith speaketh on this wise, Say not in thine heart, Who shall ascend into heaven? (that is, to bring Christ down from above:) Or, Who shall descend into the deep? (that is, to bring up Christ again from the dead.) But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach;

It is the word of faith Paul is preaching, and who was preaching this same thing? Moses. Notice the following carefully, this is where Paul is quoting from.

Deu 30:10-15 If thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to keep his commandments and his statutes which are written in this book of the law, and if thou turn unto the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul. For this commandment which I command thee this day, it is not hidden from thee, neither is it far off. It is not in heaven, that thou shouldest say, Who shall go up for us to heaven, and bring it unto us, that we may hear it, and do it? Neither is it beyond the sea, that thou shouldest say, Who shall go over the sea for us, and bring it unto us, that we may hear it, and do it? But **the word is very nigh unto thee, in thy mouth, and in thy heart, that thou mayest do it.** See, I have set before thee this day life and good, and death and evil;

That is righteousness by faith as Paul concurred, and this is what Paul is saying is the “word of faith which we preach”. It is life to do them, and death not to do them, that is again what is “written in this book of the law.” But it is believing that they are in your mouth and heart that produces righteousness. Righteousness comes by faith in the word to perform what the word has said.

Now, what must you do to have life? If thou wilt enter life, keep the law. That is the standard of righteousness. And righteousness by faith is accepting that little book of the law into your heart and mouth.

So therefore “the man that does them shall live in them”, “the man that doesn’t do them shall die in them”.

Mat 5:17-19 Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil. For verily I say unto you, **Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled. Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.**

Very simple, Take your pick, be a doer of the law and teach them as Christ said, or go about to teach and establish your own righteousness. But you will never be among the justified if you teach we aren’t to keep the law and accept by faith Christ takes the book and writes it on your heart. And Paul confirms.

Rom 3:31 Do we then make void the law through faith? God forbid: yea, we establish the law.

Eph 2:8-10 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast. (10) For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath **before ordained that we should walk in them.**

And what did God ordain that we should WALK IN?

Deu_30:16 In that I command thee this day to love the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, and to keep his commandments and his statutes and his judgments, that thou mayest live and multiply: and the LORD thy God shall bless thee in the land whither thou goest to possess it.
